School uniform

Please ensure that you follow the school uniform policy and all items of uniform are clearly labelled.

PE

This term we will have 1 PE session which will take place on a Monday. Although we do ask that all children have their PE kit in school everyday in case of changes to the timetable. Our regular PE session on a Thursday will now be our Swimming session. These will take place at Cranleigh Leisure Centre. On a Thursday the children can come into school wearing their P.E. kit. They should also bring a swimming bag; including their swimwear, towel and goggles. Swimming hats are optional.

Water

We are encouraging the children to drink of plenty of water. Please could each child bring a named water bottle which will be kept in class to school each day ensuring that the children have access to water all day.

Home learning

Homework will be set on a Friday, to be handed in by the following Friday. Children should spend no longer than 20 minutes on their homework. If your child is unable to complete the homework please send in a letter to explain why. The children should read their school book to an adult every night for appropriately 10 minutes. Please fill in your child's Reading Record.

Reading

Please ensure that they have their reading book in school with them each day. If your child needs to change their book they should do this at the beginning of the school day. Miss Board or Mrs Dunk can assist children with choosing their book if needed.

There may be occasions when we would appreciate some additional help for practical activities or something special. If you are able to help on occasions and have a school DBS check, please do let Miss Board know.
