

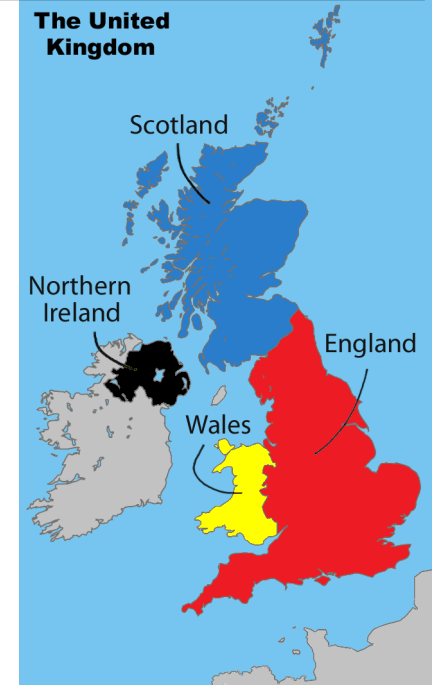
Choose ONE task to complete each half term.
