Religious Education

Using the Come and See scheme the children will learn about:

Special People, Meals and Change. We will also learn about and celebrate Ash Wednesday, Lent and Easter.

The lessons aim to develop:

Understanding English, Communication and Languages

We will be reading the story 'The Piano and the Bear.' We will talk about the setting, the characters and learn the sequence of the story. We will use this to help us invent our own story. Also we will be using our topics 'Our Local Area' and as an inspiration for different forms of non-fiction writing. Phonics 5 will be taught. The children will also be using their phonics to help with spelling. Cursive handwriting will be practised on a regular basis.

Mathematical Understanding

Tell the time to the hour and half hour. Name and order days of the week and months of the year. Use time words e.g. before and after. Revisit addition and subtraction. Remember and use number bonds to 20. Measurement – length. We will also be counting in 2s, 5s, 10s. We will be learning to multiply and divide. Finally we will start fractions. We will recognise and find a half and a quarter of a shape and a quantity.
