

Choose ONE task to complete each half term.

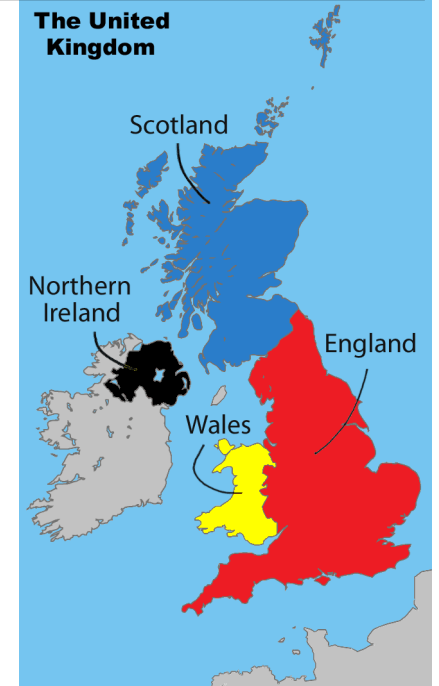
Around the UK — bring in to school on Friday 20th October
