Draw and explain what six things you would want to take with you if you were evacuated.

Make a newspaper report of a bombing on your street.

Create a timeline of events that occurred in World War II

Radiotelegraphy, using Morse code was vital during World War II, especially in carrying messages between warships and naval bases. Find out about Morse code. Write your name using Morse code. Could you construct a message?



Create your own model tank or gas mask.

Write a script for a radio news broadcast about a key event during World War 2. Perform it to the class. (You could do this with a friend)

Write and perform a song to keep people's spirits up during the war.

Bletchley Park was the central site for British codebreakers during World War II. Find out what they did and how they did it.

Make a model 3D scene from the war.



Visit the Imperial War Museum and write a diary / review about your trip.

Research and write a short biography about a famous person from WWII, e.g. Winston Churchill.

Compare and contrast fashions of Wartime Britain and Britain today.

Create a graph comparing the size of armies from different nations.

Research a WWII recipe and make it at home. Photograph it or bring it in to show us, Write out the recipe.

Write instructions or an advice leaflet for citizens to follow during an air raid.

Make your own WWII word search.

Research Anne Frank and list ten facts about her.

Find out about the airplanes flown in WWII. Draw one of the planes or even make one.
