We teach all this through prayer and worship and by following the 'Come and See' Programme as recommended by the Diocese. It is developed through three main themes, they are Church, Sacrament and Christian Living.

Each theme is explored through a different topic in each age group. The children will study nine themes during the year.

It is important that the children gain an understanding of other faiths and we study Judaism in the Autumn term. In the Summer term EYFS and Key Stage 1 learn about Hinduism, Year 3 and 4 learn about Islam and in Year 5 and 6 they learn about Sikhism.
