Research Roman numerals. Write your own maths problems using the numerals or make a board game replacing



Create your own 'mosaic' art work.

Mosaics often featured geometric designs but what other common themes were used?



Create your own Top Trumps card game based on Roman Gods.



Find out about life in the Roman army.

Create a Roman shield or helmet.



Write a short newspaper report announcing the invasion of Britain by the Romans in 43AD!
