20 minutes	COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE	The Billy Goats Gruff Listen to the story of ‘The Billy Goats Gruff’ (either own version or you can use https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=aiy3a1v9Q2E&list=PLCezSB4InxW TsYwuXKUcE7apLBC H9qOv&index=9&t=0s – to watch the story or https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xNJBzcgjIYw – to watch and listen to the story book being read). Re-tell the story with your adult. Remember to use sequencing words such as First; Next; Then; After that; In the end. Perhaps you have some small world toys to help you to tell the story? Extension Task: draw pictures for what happens at each stage of the story and write a sentence to describe what is happening. You could do a little bit each day this week.

(That you can rely on your family to look after you.) Do you feel sorry for the troll? (Maybe you do because he was hungry and needed something to eat or he didn't know any better.) Draw a picture and write what you have learnt from this story.
