



What 2-D shape did it make? Can you make a pattern? Are there any 3-D shapes which make more than one 2-D shape in the dough? Which 3-D shapes will leave a square on the dough?</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><small>© White Rice Mat</small></p> <p>Or</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Loose parts</p> <p>Provide a selection of loose parts and some frames or paper. Ask the children to make pictures and patterns. Which shapes can they see in their art work? Which loose parts are the best for making curved shapes? Blending words</p> <p>Play the snap game with tricky words Read with your child</p>	<p>Count items to 20, start at 10. They are confident counting amounts to 10. Use anything you have in the house to practice counting e.g. pasta, buttons. Remind children to put their finger on the item as they count it. Say and write the numbers.</p>	<p>RE-Listen to Mrs Moore read the story of Good Friday and talk about Easter Sunday. Write down any questions you might have about the story. Please add to home learning book or send a photo through tapestry.</p> <p>You could also make an Easter Garden.</p>

Blending words Sheet 5 of the Phonics work book Read with your child https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/please-log-in?open_loginbox=true Our log in is</p>	<p>Cut out some shapes together for example: circle, triangle, rectangle, square. Look together at describing their properties, for example, “the triangle has three sides.” Stick a shape to your child’s back. Children ask clues to guess the shape. “Does it have four sides?” “Are all the sides the same length?” Take turns to play with different shapes. Add a picture on tapestry or put a photo in your learning log.</p>	<p>Choose an activity from the Spring home learning week 2 folder.
