



Fuji San (1987) by Ted Harrison

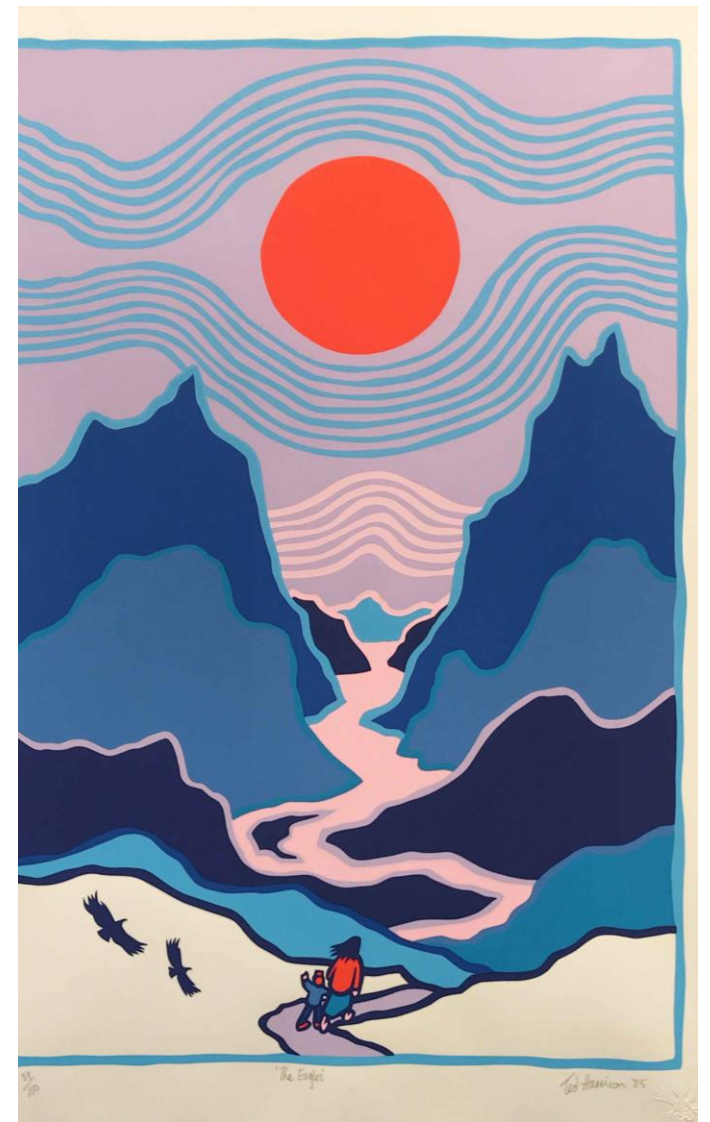


Yukon Sun, 1983

Born in 1926, in England, Ted began to create art at a young age - despite his art teacher telling him he had no talent for it!

Ted never gave up and today is one of Canada's most popular artists.

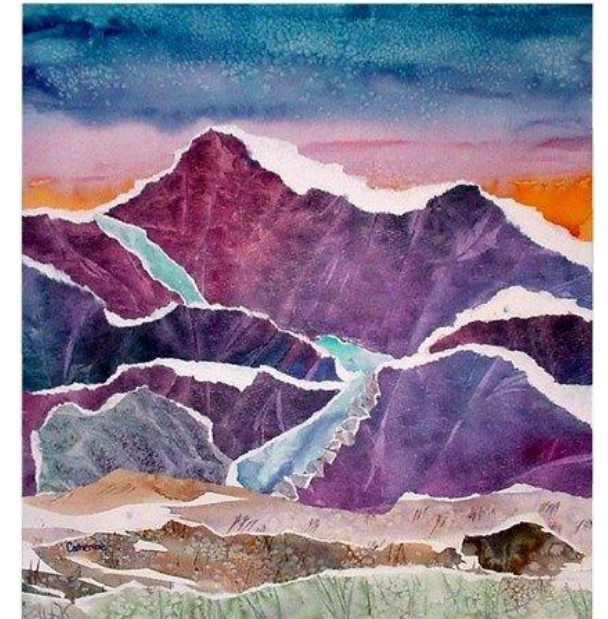


The Eagles, 1985
