- When is our special day or rest? Why do we keep this Holy? How do we keep it holy?
- Why do you think God gave us the 10 commandments? How do they help us in our lives?
- What would our world look like without his commandments?
- If you were to create 10 rules, would they be similar or different to God's ones?
- What does it mean to take God's name in vain?

Now have a go at one of these activities, or more, if you want to:

- Retell the 10 Commandments in a child- friendly way and record into your book
  - Write a poem, psalm, song or rap to teach people the 10 commandments. These can be recorded and shared with your teacher.
  - Write a set of instructions to teach people how to be a follower of God using scripture to explain
  - Create a scroll and present the 10 commandments on this, putting the scripture into your own words
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- Create a game to help you memorise the 10 commandments
  - Use one of the craft ideas below to show your learning
