KS2 – watch the following clip:

Read through the PowerPoint and discuss the following questions with your parents.

Why do you think it is important to show respect for and be stewards of God's creation?
Do you think that people respect the environment? Give reasons/examples for your answers.

In what ways could you encourage people to show greater respect for and stewardship of the environment and God's creation?

What actions would you like your school to take, to care for the environment and creation?

How have people damaged God's creation?

What do you think the consequences will be if we do not care for the world?

How can we make people more aware of the consequences of their choices?

How does the understanding that we are all called to be stewards of creation shape the lives of believers?

How can you be a steward of creation?

Activities for KS2:

Choose one of the activities below.

Write a prayer to God asking him to help the people of the world to look after his precious gift

Write a letter to the people of the world reminding them why it is so important to look after our precious world. Explain what the consequences will be if we do not care for the world and explain what actions they can take to care for creation.

Write a letter to your headteacher telling him/her what actions would you like your school to take, to care for the environment and creation.

If you have time, using the leaf template, write on cut out leaves ideas of ways to care for the earth and the reasons why we should care for it. You could then draw the trunk of a tree and add the leaves to it to a 'Tree of Stewardship'.
