### Maths fluency

Ask your child to keep practising their times tables and arithmetic skills as they are really important.

- -Times tables: 2,5 and 10
- Number bonds to 10, 20 and even 100! Number bonds are simply pairs of numbers that make up a given number e.g. What number do you pair with 7 to make 10? What number do you pair with 5 to make 10?
